

Más Amor 2017, DO Cataluña Franck Massard

Más Amor or *More Love* echoes the livelihood of Barcelona. We deliberately choose this *graffiti* painted on the wall that represents the urban art of this city full of energy. The picture was taken on 14th February 2010 (St Valentine's Day). Más Amor is the expression of a rosé coming from the slopes of the Ebro river. The house where the photo was taken no longer exist, it was destroyed a few days after the picture was taken.

Origin

Do Catalunya. Grapes come from vineyards located at the villages of El Masroig, Falset and Els Guiamets. The vines are about 25 years old.

Grape varieties

80% Grenache and 20% Tempranillo

Technical data

Alcohol degree: 13%

Ph: 3,25 Acidity: 4.5 g/l

Vinification

At the moment of the harvest, the grapes were at the good point of ripeness, keeping a good acidity and therefore, providing freshness to the wine.

Maceration with the skins was carried out for 4 hours to avoid extraction of too many polyphenols and tannins. Alcoholic fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks for around 2 weeks at controlled temperature.

Vintage notes

The winter previous to the harvest came with very soft temperatures. The climate during the entire growing season was drier than usual, with few rain episodes. The quality of the grapes was excellent.

Tasting notes

Más Amor 2017 is paler in color than the previous vintage. Citric aromas on the nose, lime and orange and little strawberries notes. Very light, fresh, easy-drinking on the palate, reminiscent of grapefruit and a hint of peppermint. The perfect partner for salads and fish.
